CEP Emeritus Status:

Section. 5.15 of the ABCEP Bylaws:

A CEP who is fully retired from active professional practice, who was certified through examination in accordance with these bylaws, and who has maintained active dues-paying status as a member for a minimum of five consecutive years, and wishes to relinquish their CEP certification, may petition the Board of Trustees to become a CEP emeritus.

A. A CEP emeritus will pay no annual dues, will be listed in the Annual Roster under a separate section, and may participate in the activities of the Academy.

B. If the CEP Emeritus petitions to reacquire the CEP active certification, the person must petition the Board to return to active status. Upon Board approval, the person may be reinstated. This request can be honored only once during a holder's lifetime.

How it works:

A petition to the ABCEP Board of Trustees is done using the form above and mailed or faxed (410-254-5542) to the ABCEP Office. The Board will address the petition at their next regularly scheduled meeting, and you will be informed of their decision via mail or email. Notes:

“Fully retired from active professional practice” means those who have retired from their working career or who have switched professions and are not active in professional practice in the environmental arena.

“Maintained active dues-paying status” means paid dues to ABCEP since the ABCEP dues program was initiated in 2000.
